5. To troiter, becament, tent, shack, garage, barn or other outballding erected in the tract shall at any time be used as a

residence, temporarily or permanently, nor shall any structure of a temporary character be used as a residence.

Any grade change exceeding 18 inches or more must have the approval of the irchitertonal Committee.

The appurention reserves the right to enter upon any lot for the purpose of moving and concerns. right to enter upon any lot for the purphet of moving and removing any unsightly weeds or other veletation, trimming hedges, trees at shrubs, removing deed or unsightly portions thereof and requiring malls or other appurtment structures, whenever the owner or occur, of any property shall fail or reques to do so within a responsible time after notice in writing from the Board of Directors of the

existence of the objectionable condition.

11. Brection and maintenance of any stable or other chalter for livestock of foil and the keeping of dog kennels, livestock and fowl within the subdivision are prohibited. A dog enclosure of galvanized chain link fencing may be permitted with the Board of Directors permission, provided the fence is no more than 48 inches in height and is located behind the rear house line and no closer to alde lot lines than the building line and no closer to the rear line them 20 feet. Only one dog may be permitted in said enclosure. Only feater may be permitted with the Board of Directors permission, provided the feater is no more than 48 inches of Directors permission, provided the fence is no more than 48 inche in height and is located around the back yard only, being no closer to the front than the rear house line. Outside train containers are prohibited. No filling material shall be brought in and used on any lot except unmixed with, above, gravel or sand. Earth removed from obtiding late must be utilized within the subdivision at the discretion of the Architecture! Considered.

No sign, billboard or shape displayed for advertising or the display of advertising material of any kind shall be placed or maintained within the subdivision; now shall any notice or after timesent be displayed by any permis, apporation or association, corrying on a permitted business or a trade or profession therein, without the permission in writing of the Board or Directors of the Dear Ridge Cooperative senses of the Board or Directors of the
